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7) According to your work in the CEBundle, what are your values?

8) What have you learned about yourself from your experiences in life? (Did you find that you hate babysitting or food service? Did you find that you love organizing things or talking to people?...things like that.)

9) Go to onet.com. Look up as several careers that meet your personality type and interest. Tool around on the website. Which careers will also fit your strengths and values? Which ones have the best outlook for employment in the future?

10) Look at local college websites. Do they have majors that train students for careers you are interested in? (Look at local state, Christian and private colleges.) Expand your search through Google or College Board's Big Future page. Compare required courses for the majors in each of the colleges. This may vary widely. Compare entrance requirements. This is time consuming but vital because different colleges offer slightly different majors.

11) Pray. Do this before you start, during your search, and after you choose.
